

Shuler Theater actress fights cancer with comedy

RATON — Just before Christmas, First United Methodist Church pastor Adrienne Coleman was ringing the Salvation Army bell outside the El Raton Movie Theatre when Shuler Theater director Gail Dixon-Willden arrived for a movie. Coleman surprised herself when she offered, on a whim, “If you ever want a strong female lead, I’m your gal.”

Then she got a New Year’s present she didn’t want. On Jan. 2, she was diagnosed with breast cancer.

The next month, on Mardi Gras Fat Tuesday, she took the role of Vivian in the Kaleidoscope Players’ summer repertory musical comedy “Church Basement Ladies,” which opened at the Shuler Theater June 28 and continues through Aug. 4.

“This is a way to say ‘cancer is only a word,’” she says. “It’s a bad word, but it doesn’t have to stop you. Not only can you go on with your life, but you can also start something new. I’ve found the stage to be an effective adjunct to cancer treatments.”

She received chemotherapy in Pueblo for five months, from January to May. Her hair loss, she says, “makes it easier to wear the wig” of her stage character, Vivian.

She had a lumpectomy last Monday and faces five years of drug therapy.

“I’m proud to say that I haven’t missed a Sunday in the pulpit. That’s been part of my goal of pushing forward positively. You get so wrapped up in the medical side of the treatments. The theater side of my life has been a good countermeasure. The laughter and play

have been invigorating and energizing therapy for me.”

Rehearsals ran nine hours a day, six days a week for several weeks. She over-

came joint pain, lack of energy, and the rigors of rehearsal to sing and dance and laugh in her first stage role since 1979.

After doing college theater in Denton, Texas, she married, moved to Farmington, N.M., and had four children who are now

33, 29, 21 and 16 years old. (The youngest, Nathan, will play the lead role of Willie Wonka in the Shuler’s children’s theater production Aug. 10-12.) She acted with the San Juan Stage Company and directed “Hello Dolly” and “Fiddler on the Roof.”

Then she got busy raising four kids and didn’t mount a stage for more than thirty years.

Well, not exactly. Along with fellow Raton pastor and stage actor Rick Trice, she says, “When people ask us how long it’s been since we were on the stage, we say, ‘Last Sunday.’”

“The biggest difference,” she says, “is that in church, the lights are on and you can see the audience.”

Most of her parishioners, both from the Raton congregation and Grace United Methodist Church in Des Moines — the two churches are “yoked” and share one pastor — have already come to see her in “Church Basement Ladies.” Coleman, who arrived in Raton in 2010, says, “My parishioners view my act-

ing as a good way for their pastor to be connected to the community.”

Although the play is an ensemble piece, Coleman’s character of Vivian is the one with the greatest challenge and change. “She’s the matriarch of the kitchen and probably a lifelong member of the church. She pulls the strings, but she’s feeling the rug pulled out from under her by the younger women.”

It’s a theme that resonates for Coleman. “I’ve been preaching for a couple years about our need to embrace change,” she says. “People defer to Vivian in the play, but they’re also trying to pull her forward into the changes represented by the present day.”

Coleman recently saw something posted on Facebook that has stuck with her: “It said that when something bad happens to you, there are three choices: you can let it define you, destroy you, or strengthen you.”

She’s responded to her cancer by returning to the stage, even with its daunting demands. Not only has she embraced change, but she’s used it to strengthen herself.

“Church Basement Ladies” continues at the Shuler Theater and tonight at 7:30 p.m. On July 27 and Aug. 4 there will be two shows each day, a 2:30 p.m. matinee followed by a 7:30 p.m. evening show.

General admission tickets are available at the door — \$15 adults, \$13 seniors, and \$5 children. Additional information is available at the Shuler Theater, (575) 445-4746.
